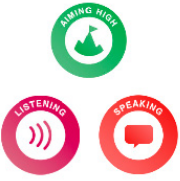


FULL RIBBON FRAMEWORK YEARS 9-11

Students in Years 9-11 work towards their “Full Ribbons” which will be awarded to them during their graduation ceremony in Year 11. To receive full ribbons students need to meet the criteria below, arrange the evidence in the order below in their folders and submit them completed by the given deadline.

The word “annotate” means to write a few sentences or a short paragraph describing what we are looking at in the photo, for example, “The photo above is of me playing football/netball, I go to training every week and participate in matches. I have been a member of this team for 3 years and have won the following competitions....”

House Captain, Sports Captain, Head Student OR Leading clubs and involvement in extracurricular activities OR 3 pieces of evidence of service to the school (can include subject ambassadors, open evening)
